### *Insurance Claim Finalized:*

State Farm has completed processing our claim after we supplied information for all their questions. They are sending out a cash-settlement cheque for \$17,275.19. In addition, there is a "replacement cost benefit" that we can avail ourselves of if we decide to purchase a replacement item over the cash-settlement value for that item.

There is a 2-year window to making use of the RCB and a policy limit of \$23,030 (settlement check plus RCB).

There will be instructions and an inventory listing with the cheque so we'll know what we can collect with the RCB.

There will be discussions over the next few months on acquiring the essentials that we need to operate the club. The key items are tractor mower versus lawn cutting services, storage building and sun shelter, trainer equipment.
