

# **Aurora Model Aircraft Club**

## **Safety Code for Indoor Flying**

- 1) All in attendance are to be Members of the Aurora Model Aircraft club. All Guests are to be accompanied by a member. Guests are permitted one visit before being required to join.
- 2) All pilots are to peg on the frequency board before turning on their transmitters.
- 3) All pilots are to have current and valid MAAC insurance.
- 4) Pilots stations are only allowed on the side of the gym that contains the stands
- 5) Pilots should try and avoid flying directly over the stands (which double as pits)
- 6) All Pilots are to announce when they are going to retrieve an aircraft from the Gym floor. At times like this, it is requested that pilots with planes in the air, fly as close to the ceiling as possible, or announce that they are going to land. In this instance the pilot with the downed aircraft will wait until the other pilot lands.
- 7) On evenings were there are more than 8 members in attendance, the evening's convener may put a limit on the number of plans in the air at one time. This request might also be made if a member is testing a new aircraft or wanting to fly a very fragile plane.

Our Goal is to insure that all in attendance have a good time and practice a safety first approach to flying indoors
